BEWARE OF ILLEGAL WASTE COLLECTORS

DO NOT GIVE YOUR WASTE TO UNAUTHORISED COLLECTORS. IF IN DOUBT ASK... to see their Waste Collection Permit, which will be issued by the National Waste Collection Permit Office (NWCPO) or Dublin City Council.

IF YOU

- Are aware of any illegal operators in your area
- Suspect that someone may be collecting waste without the necessary permit
- Want to check if a waste collector has a permit
- Contact Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council Enforcement Unit with collector's name and vehicle registration.

Dispose of your waste correctly by bringing it to your nearest recycling facility. Many items are **free of charge** like electrical goods fluorescent tubes, batteries, and waste oils. There is a cost for some bulky items but the cost of correct disposal is far cheaper than a **€4,000 FINE** if convicted. If buying a new electrical appliance, under the WEEE regulations, the old one can be taken back by the supplier.
